NO COVID-19 TEST COMPLETED

Student(s) will be Presumed Positive

Student may return to school once **ALL** below are met:

- After at least 10 days from the start of the illness OR 14 days after a positive exposure
- Student has had no fever over 100° for at least 3 days
- 3. Student's symptoms are improving



POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

Student(s) will isolate at home according to public health guidelines. Student(s) may return to school:

- 1. After at least 10 days from the start of the illness
- 2. Student has had no fever over 100° for at least 3 days
- 3. Student's symptoms are improving



NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST OR OTHER ILLNESS IDENTIFIED*

To return to school, student(s) must provide a note from a healthcare provider confirming a non-COVID-19 illness.

Student may return to school according to school policies dictated by diagnosed illness.

*Other illness means either a test showed the student had a non-COVID-19 illness OR the student had symptoms consistent with a non-COVID-19 illness.
